

## Conflict Minerals Policy


Elproman AB supports all efforts to prohibit the illegal trade with conflict minerals. For this, we refer to the EU Conflict Minerals Regulation, published on May 19, 2017 and taking effect on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2021. Its intention is that raw materials like tin, tungsten, tantalum or gold should not be sourced from the conflict regions; thereby withdrawing the financial basis for wars and conflicts in these regions.

Elproman AB cooperates only with suppliers who source their raw materials or materials in an ethical manner.

Based on the restrictions for using “Conflict Minerals”, we request from our suppliers transparency and open communication regarding source and procurement of their materials.

Therefore, we declare that all of the components delivered by Elproman AB have to be seen as “conflict free” until further notice.
